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You may, at a later date, be invited to an interview before a small Sub-committee who will welcome you as a member of our Society. This interview will take place at our Headquarters situated at **The Romford United Services and Social Club, 28 Mawney Road, Romford, RM7 7HB**. All members of the Society have undergone this interview as an introduction to the Society. At time of application you will be required to provide two recent passport size photographs of yourself and any other joint applicants for your Membership Cards.

The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), became law on 25th May 2018 and together with the Data Protection Act 2018 came about because of the need for consistency in applying data protection law. It also strengthens the rules around personal data and requires organisations to be more accountable and transparent about their handling of data. EPHDAS encourage this, as we recognise the importance of individual preference, that consenting to the holding of data on an individual basis is a choice that each Member has. We would encourage Members to opt in to help facilitate the running of the Society to ensure Members are contacted and notified of club activities such as AGM notification and renewals. However, this is not a requirement of being a Member of the Society. If Members choose to opt out of data holding, EPHDAS will delete as per the regulations any physical or electronic data associated with your Membership. We would urge Members in this instance to regularly attend General meetings to be aware of changes, dates, AGM timetable etc as we will not be able to contact you directly.

Junior Members aged 13 or below will require the direct consent of Parent or Guardian so that EPHDAS can process Membership renewal. Junior Member aged 13 or below will only require information to be held for emergency purposes and as per EPHDAS rule book must be accompanied always by an EPHDAS Full Member. Membership can only be granted with this consent form completed and signed.
